Sweden is a Nordic country in northern Europe

The population is just over 10 million or 0.13% of the world's population

Swedish is the main language, with five official minority languages

Constitutional monarchy, with parliamentary democracy







SWEDEN AND SOUTH AFRICA

Sweden strongly supported the struggle for democracy in South Africa during the apartheid period.

South African exports to Sweden include mineral products, wood products, machinery and mechanical appliances.

South Africa mainly imports products such as electrical equipment, chemical products, wood pulp, textiles as well as machinery from Sweden.

A South African – Swedish Binational Commission was inaugurated in September 2000

Funded by the Swedish Ministry for Foreign Affairs. Offers a unique opportunity to develop both professionally and academically, experience Swedish society and culture, and build a long lasting relationship with Sweden and other scholarship holders.

For ambitious professionals who want to make a difference by working with issues that contribute to just and sustainable development in their home country and region.

Applicants should have a clear idea of how the study programme in Sweden would benefit their home country or region. Priority will be given to applicants with a strong and relevant professional background and demonstrated leadership experience.

Final selection by Swedish Institute

Applicants must first apply to a Swedish university via the central, online application system Scholarship applications open after the university application period closes and must be done separately

You will only be considered for the scholarship if you are admitted to one of your selected programmes





WHAT DOES THE SCHOLARSHIP COVER?

Tuition fees

Living expenses of SEK 10,000/month (approx. R17 000)

Travel grant of SEK 15,000 (approx. R25 500) for the entire scholarship period

Insurance against illness and accident

ADMISSIONS.SE

University Admissions is responsible for the admissions process together with Sweden's universities.

There are 39 universities and university colleges in Sweden, offering courses and programmes taught in English.

At <u>Universityadmissions.se</u> you can:

- learn about the entry requirements
- apply for courses and programmes
- submit your academic documents
- follow your application from start to finish
- receive your admissions decision





APPLYING FOR DHET SUPPORT WITH APPLICATION FEE

The DHET application form can be found on our scholarships website

The Department of Higher Education and Training will fund up to 15 candidates' Swedish university application fees.

It is intended for those who are not able to cover this fee themselves and would not otherwise be able to apply for the scholarship. The outcome of the DHET application has **NO** bearing on your applications for Swedish universities NOR for the Swedish Institute for Global Professionals Scholarship.

Applicants will be selected on the basis of merit, need and alignment with the university and scholarship eligibility. The process is competitive and the decision of the Department is final.

Don't wait until the last minute, plan and prepare your application well in advance.

Proof read, ask someone else to proof read. Submit your best possible application.

Make sure you are eligible and have submitted everything that is required, follow all instructions.







MORE TIPS FOR APPLICANTS

Understand the scholarship's objectives and link your application to them

Demonstrate why you're the strongest candidate – scholarships are competitive

Know why you're applying, what you want from the scholarship and what you want to do afterwards

In 2022 the Swedish Institute will grant about 350 scholarships for master's degree studies in Sweden to students from 42 countries.
