

Prof. Jude T. Lubega is a distinguished academic and professional in the field of Information Technology. He is currently the Vice Chancellor of Nkumba University. With a wealth of experience in ICT for Development (ICT4D), over the years, Prof. Lubega has held numerous significant roles. These include being a Deputy Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs at Uganda Technology and Management University (UTAMU) and Head of the Information Technology Department at Makerere University. He has been an Independent Evaluation Committee Member for both the African Host Universities for the RSIF and the RUFORUM Young Innovators Awards. He also

chaired the Task Force for the establishment of the Institute of IT Professionals in Uganda and served as a Director at UTAMU.

Jude has been a key figure in the ICT sector as the Chief Executive Officer of 8Tech Consults Limited since 2009 and as a member of the ICT Committee of the Inter-University Council for East Africa. His contributions have been recognised globally, including being listed among the 100 Movers and Shakers in Corporate Online Learning in Africa for 2018. Within these many years of practice, Prof. Lubega's extensive research and consultancy work span e-learning, data science, mobile computing, and ICT strategic planning, contributing significantly to the development of information systems and ICT innovations in education, governance, and health sectors.
