For 39 years, funding from UMSAEP has supported over 900 faculty exchanges, involving more than 50 different academic departments on all four UM system campuses with UWC. Many of these exchanges have generated externally funded research projects, produced publications or led to curriculum and professional development initiatives. Funding is also available for research collaborations with other South African institutions.

Successful proposals include clear evidence that faculty members at each institution are committed to a productive collaboration. We recommend that interested faculty establish strong communication with potential exchange collaborators. Rod Uphoff, UMSAEP director, is happy to advise and assist in identifying and introducing potential UM collaborators.
